	8oz SR flour	1 tbsp honey
	80z sultanas	1tsp ground cinnamon

Methos: Cream together the margarine and sugar until light and fluffy, gradually add eggs and honey. Fold in flour, cinnamon and chopped apple. Pour into a lined 8"/20cm square tin. Bake in a moderate oven (325/350f, 170/180c, gas 3-4) for approx 1-11/4 hours until risen and golden brown.
