NEW TO KINGSBRIDGE SHOW IN 2025!

No entrance fee. Age to be stipulated on Entry Form for judging purposes. Two adult wristbands will be allocated for each entry. **Exhibits to be in place by 9.00am in the Horticultural Marquee.**

Each exhibitor will be provided with a 1m x 1m base to display their crafts. Each year, a new theme will be given and exhibitors will display a range of 5 different crafts linked to this theme. The base will be plain white but exhibitors can personalise the base with temporary decoration that must be removed when exhibits are taken down. The items are marked separately as well as given a total of points overall.

2025 Theme: Woodland

Craft 1 - Natural Artwork. Using flowers, natural resources etc in a suitable container.

Craft 2 – Cookery/Baking. This craft will be tasted so must be covered with cling film.

Craft 3 – Poem. Written by yourself; presentation considered when judging.

Craft 4 – Artwork. An item such as drawing, painting, collage in any medium.

Craft 5 – Photograph. Capturing the theme and showing skill in the shot.
